


Tours and Excursions Information

Tour to the majestic Grand Canyon through scenic Sedona: Sedona will be our first stop along the tour. Guests will have a chance to photograph





ponderosa pines of the Coconino National Forest. Atop the Mogollon Rim we will travel the outskirts of the Route 66 town of Flagstaff on our way to the South Rim of the Grand Canyon. You'll experience about three hours within the National Park marveling at the beauty that is the Grand Canyon. While at the South Rim of the Grand Canyon National Park, you will have opportunities to walk the rim, shop, capture an unlimited number of photographs, or enjoy your lunch and relax with the best seat in the house. We will also explore the famous 30-mile section of road that winds east along the rim of the canyon, showcasing the best views and history along the way.

Before returning to Phoenix from the Grand Canyon, we will be treated to distant views of the Painted Desert as well as close views of the Little Colorado River Gorge and Navajo Nation. The Painted Desert is the perfect backdrop for our stop in the Navajo Nation at a prominent trading post. You will be able to get a glimpse into the past, view the highest quality authentic Navajo artwork and craft work, as well as a gift shop to bring back souvenirs for friends and family.

Phoenix and Scottsdale City Tour: As we tour the Valley of the Sun, you will be treated to sights of famous architecture modern art, desert views and the individuality that make this desert oasis magical. This halfday City Highlights tour showcases the largest county by population in Arizona - Maricopa County. Maricopa County has a tremendous diversity



of culture, scenery and history on display, set against the backdrop of the Sonoran Desert. Areas of interest on your Phoenix and Scottsdale City Highlights Tour include South Mountain Park or Papago Park, the Arizona Biltmore, Old Town Scottsdale, Downtown Phoenix and



the Arizona State Capitol building. Both South Mountain and Papago Park are elevated areas from which expansive views of the city can be enjoyed. The Arizona Biltmore is the only existing luxury hotel with design elements from the famous architect Frank Lloyd Wright. Built in 1929, the Biltmore was crowned the "Jewel of the Desert" and has been the preferred resort

for past and present celebrities, heads of state and champions of business. This famous hotel is nestled within the stunning Biltmore Estates neighborhood, which will also be included on this portion of the tour, providing unique, up-close views of Wright's architectural influences. Old Town Scottsdale provides guests with numerous options to explore the many art galleries and fashion shops, as well as enjoy some fine cuisine from around the Southwest. Downtown Phoenix, home to the historic Arizona Capitol building, provides for a unique metro area where sports fans, fashion buffs and history enthusiasts intermingle.
