Lady Kristine Sheridan Grand High Priestess for 2018-2019

Lady Kris has chosen as the Special Project: <u>"YEAR OF REHABILITATION</u>"

This year's Special Project is the Year of Rehabilitation for our Shriner Children. Personally knowing some Shriner Children, I have gained an appreciation of the importance of helping a child go beyond the surgeries, to develop physically and mentally to their full potential.

The twenty-two Shriners Hospitals offer special rehabilitation programs for the children in their care including, but are not limited to, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech language therapy, psychiatric therapy to help a child manage pain, post-traumatic stress and depression and recreational therapy which includes art, aquatic, pet and horticulture approaches. The goal of our project is to provide support of rehabilitation programs across the Shriners Hospitals System. Your donations to this Special Project will be divided equally among the Shriners Hospitals in the United States, thereby supporting the Rehabilitation Programs where ever children in your area receive care.



Shriners' Hospital for Children, Canadian Unit, Montreal will benefit in the Year of Rehabilitation. Because of Canadian Charities Rules the money donated by our Canadian court is required to stay in Canada, so I am working with the Hospital to determine a project that would benefit their Rehabilitation Program this year.

Below is the list of activities and ideas which were exchanged between the members who attended our Sunday afternoon session. Thanks to Lady Charlene for collecting this information. Please help me by looking these over and think about how we need to prioritize these and do some goal setting for this year. I don't know if we will be asked do another presentation but I still want to have some goals and keep our ball rolling.

Members Ideas/Activities:

- 1. Have casual open membership nights where ladies and men can come together to learn about LOS. Ex: pizza or sub party
- Unit performances: ask for a table to be used for membership presentation.
- Holding a balloon twisting class: open to public. 3.
- 4. Making fund raisers open to the public.
- 5. Motorcycle runs in conjunction with the Shrine temple Nobles.
- Participating in a Community Day: painting side of a building for children 6.
- Local TV appearances: to promote fund raiser, as wall as Organization. 7.
- Masonic Lodge visits: ask to speak with wives 8.
- 9. Working with temple reorder: asking for new members contract info 10. If you are a "first-line signer" of a petition, stay in contact with the person. Helps to make them feél welcomed.
- 11. Present members with Certificates of Appreciation for years of membership, i.e. 5, 10, 15, 20 years, etc. This recognitions helps with retention of members. Maybe do at a Ceremonial, so new members know older members are appreciated.
- 12. If there appears to be no support or relationship with local Shrine Center, go, talk with them and keep trying . Maybe offer to host a meal, assist with a function, offer to help in some way. Little things just may open the door. Making donations to the transportation fund helps to show the Philanthropic support. May donate to some special activity the Temple is having. Anything to encourage a relationship.
- 13. Wear Court Shirts or attire to functions. People might ask what the logo is, or what Organization you represent. This opens the discussion to promote LOS both locally and nationally.
 14. Keep flyer or membership brochure handy to pass out if anyone asks.
 15. End each Court meeting with a "Cheer": "This is a great Court..." this leaves members feeling
- good and positive about their Court.
- 16. Ask to attend the Shrine Center Ceremonials: speak to the ladies maybe at a breakfast or luncheon. Ask if you can have a membership table in a hallway or back of the room.
- Ambassador group visits to Masonic Functions.
 "Girls Night Out" Group: members plan casual "girly" activities such as going to a chick flick", dinner, pay, etc. And invite friends and family to attend. If ladies get to see that the members have fun together, they way be more inclined to think about joining . Helps outside ladies realize it's not all about meetings!
