Associate Princess

A new year has begun and I am excited to announce our Court Hospital Project for 2019-2020. I have worked closely with Nathan Clark, at the Salt Lake City hospital in determining their needs for a monetary project. The Wheelchair, Seating and Positioning Department always has great need as it provides not only cus-

tomized wheelchair services, but also includes position mapping for continued "fit" of the patient, and maintenance and repairs on the equipment.

In addition, Salt Lake City technicians and staff are addressing a problem with mo-bility for infants and toddlers who are lacking mobility on their own. They have devel-oped a prototype chair using a commercially available "Bumbo" seat. The Bumbo seat has been modified with a base, wheels, a toggle driver, and a front tray to help these smaller kids without limbs become mobile and more independent.



Here is a report from the mother of the child using the prototype chair:

"Maria is absolutely loving her new chair! She has wanted to be in it all day. She is al-

ready navigating the hallways pretty well. The extra room in front is turning out to be a great tray. She used it for driving her stuffed bears around and even helped me make lunch by driving items from the fridge to the counter where I was working. We also discovered the chair is the perfect size to fit under her little floor/ bed table, so she can drive right up to play on her iPad. I can tell already that this chair is going to be a life changing addition for her to be so much more independent at home. Thank you so much for all the work you put into this project and for letting Maria be your first tester! It is going to be such a blessing to her and so many other kids in the future!"

In addition to monetary donations, with an attempt to raise \$6,000, we will be collecting goods for the Salt Lake and Mexico City hospitals. Toys, coloring books, games, blankets, gift cards in any denomination, and the usual items you have all generously donated over the years, are welcome! For the May 28, 2019 (TUESDAY) meeting, let's try having an old-fashioned underwear march!! Bring

any type of **white** underwear for the march. Let's start the year off on the right foot. If you are unable to attend Court and would like to donate goods, please contact me and I'll be happy to pick them up or find a way to get them to Phoenix, if you are outside of the area. 


SPHINX COURT #65, LOSNA - RULES AND **REGULATIONS PROPOSED CHANGES** FIRST READING April 22, 2019 SECOND READ-ING AND VOTE TO BE May 28, 2019 **ARTICLE 1 - COURT MEMBERSHIP & DU-**TIES

Now reads: The initiation fee for petition to this Court shall be not less than \$65.00, which includes the annual dues of \$25.00. Both the initiation fee and the annual dues must accompany the application for membership. At time of initiation each new member shall receive complimentary meals for ceremonial, a current dues card, copy of the Bylaws, copy of the Cac-tus Chatter, a membership pin, and a roster. Those initiated between 1/1 and 3/31 will receive, in addition, the dues card for the following year.

Amend to read: The initiation fee for petition to this Court shall be not less than \$70.00, which includes the annual dues of \$30.00. Both the initiation fee and the annual dues must accompany the application for membership. At time of initiation each new member shall receive complimentary meals for ceremonial, a current dues card, copy of the Bylaws, copy of the Cactus Chattér, a membership pin, and a roster. Those initiated between 1/1 and 3/31 will receive, in addition, the dues card for the following year.
